Blurb for Eventbrite: Dear Colleagues, you are warmly invited to the concluding event for the project Teachers AHEAD. This three-year project began in 2018 with partners in Italy, Spain, France, Bulgaria and the UK. In response to the OECD report 2017 and building on the outcomes and outputs for the PEAK project (2016-2018), Teachers AHEAD set out to develop transversal digital and social dimensions in education, working with educators, planners and implementors in partner countries. More specifically, the project has developed skills in the use of new technologies and comfort with modern learning environments including internet and digital platforms with attention to the human relationship between learner and teacher. The project taps into digital agendas to foster innovation, economic growth and progress, promotes digital citizenship and draws attention to knowledge sources for skills required by new professions of tomorrow. Inclusion is central to the project, an extension of integration, with attention to global migratory flows.

This is an opportunity to engage with international networks of practice and scholarship and to obtain two of the project outputs, a board game and an app to promote inclusion.
